

### No. 9 MINE & MUSEUM LANSFORD, PA

Honors a CCEDC member business that attracts guests and visitors to provide amusement, recreation, hospitality and/or culture. These businesses include: restaurants, theaters, bed & breakfasts, wineries, driving ranges and eco-tourism.

The Panther Creek Valley Foundation, a nonprofit organization. Foundation, was incorporated in 1990 for the purpose of preserving the Coaldale No. 9 Mine site as a museum (and later a tour mine) for future generations. Restoration work began on the mine itself in 1994 and continued until the first tours were offered in 2002. Since then, we have grown to welcome 14,000 visitors per year and are expecting more in the future. With the addition of the new Dorrance Colliery Fan Exhibit Building (funded through a federal grant administered by the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania), we will add a new, one-of-akind historical attraction to our site. Our facility offers many unique historic pieces including the only mine shaft that can be seen in the Anthracite Region, a miner's hospital cut into solid rock, our museum housed in the original Wash Shanty, and now the largest mine fan ever installed in the Anthracite Region which will be on display in our new building.

### Volunteer of the Year Esther Meier


Honors an outstanding individual dedicated to supporting CCEDC and other community organizations causes.

Esther Meier is a wife and mother of 4. She has been, at different times of her life, a Registered Nurse, a full-time stay at home mom, and a full-time caregiver of her 2 elderly parents and mother-in law. She now works part-time for Catholic Charities-Carbon County for the Diocese of Allentown. The most rewarding part of her life now is her time spent volunteering for the St. Vincent de Paul Society of SS Peter and Paul Catholic Church in Lehighton, PA. She has been a member of the Society since the conference was formed in 2021 and the president since September of 2022. The Society of St. Vincent de Paul is a Catholic non-profit volunteer organization which seeks to serve people in need, bring faith to life, and build a more just world. Esther believes that we are all brothers and sisters in Christ and therefore we must show Christ to others by helping those in our neighborhood who are less fortunate.



Through her volunteer work at the Society, she has made many home visits to neighbors in need and helped them with food. clothing, financial needs such as housing expenses, utilities, car payment, car repairs, phone bills, etc. She also runs Vincent's Closet, a clothing exchange which takes donations of clothing. personal care items, blankets, household items and food and gives them to the needy and homeless in the area. She gives rides to appointments and shopping for those with no transportation. Through St. Vincent de Paul, she has also organized community dinners and dinners for the homeless. This past winter, she was instrumental in opening, along with other members of the St. Vincent de Paul Society and volunteers from numerous churches in the area, "Operation Cold Front", a cold weather shelter, in the basement of St. Peter's Community Resource Center in Weissport, PA. The shelter provided a warm place to sleep, food and clothing for homeless in the area if the weather was forecasted to go below 25 degrees overnight. The shelter ran from January to March of 2024, entirely funded and staffed by volunteers. She is diligently working with others in the community at this time to open the cold weather shelter again this winter at a different location.

Esther is also a founding member of Bridgeway Community Services, a non-profit organization dedicated to bringing a new permanent homeless shelter and transitional housing to Carbon County and the surrounding areas. Esther holds a Bachelor of Science degree in Nursing from Roberts Wesleyan University in Rochester, NY.

### WILLIAM H. BAYER LIFETIME ACHIEVEMENT AWARD

### PETER KERN (POSTHUMOUSLY)

This award is in honor of the late William H. Bayer and is presented each year to a CCEDC member that has demonstrated a lifetime commitment to our community.

Peter Kern's dedication to the Carbon County Community was second to none. Peter began his career at the New Jersey Zinc Company in 1965, working on major projects across the world. He resigned from his position of Senior Vice President in 1988 to become President and CEO of Palmerton Hospital, a position he held until his retirement in 2000. He served in a volunteer role as President of the Palmerton Hospital Foundation for five additional years.

In addition to his professional career, he was actively involved in community activities. He was elected to two terms as a director of the Pleasant Valley School District and served two years as board president. He later served 10 years as the president of the Pleasant Valley School District Foundation



He served almost 30 years as president of the Palmerton Area Chamber of Commerce and was instrumental in the founding of the Carbon County Chamber of Commerce. He served the latter organization as director for 10 years, including four years as its chairman.

He was a member of the advisory board of St. John Neumann Regional School, Palmerton, where he also served eight years as mentor to the school's Chess Team. Since 2010, he served as treasurer of the Palmerton Area Historical Society.

He was actively involved in the mergers of Lutheran Welfare Services of Hazleton, Lutheran Home at Topton and Tressler Lutheran Services of Mechanicsburg to form Diakon Lutheran Service Ministries. He served these organizations as a director for 25 years and at various times as vice chairman, corporate secretary, and chairman of the Compensation Committee. Upon his retirement, he was given the distinguished honor of director emeritus.

In 2009, he was elected to the board of directors of the Allentown Symphony Association, where he served as chairman of the Governance Committee and as a member of the Executive Committee. In 2013, he was elected board president and was very active in obtaining broad-based community financial support for the organization.


### 2024 Business of the Year
