




#### Income & Wages: Per Capita Personal Income (PCPI)









### PROPRIETOR'S INCOME AS A PERCENT OF PERSONAL INCOME (2022)






### ARTS, ENTERTAINMENT AND RECREATION AS A PERCENT OF TOTAL EMPLOYMENT (2022)










